During the worship service there is a nursing room (on the second floor behind the balcony) for parents to care for their babies during the service.

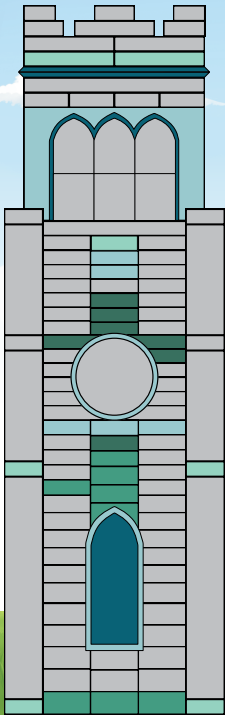
